

ORDER


UPON THIS MOTION EXPARTE dated and filed on





3. LEAVE is also granted the applicant for the service of the Originating Summons and other accompanying court processes on the Respondents in Abuja;




4. That the motion on notice is adjourned to Friday, 28th February, 2014 for hearing.
